Application

Remove cap – pen is immediately ready for use. Dab on glaze with the tip of the pen as much as required – using no pressure – or apply with short strokes.

If too much glaze has been applied and therefore the application becomes too dark, it can be toned down with wire wool after it has begun to dry.

In case of 'strongly soaking', untreated or raw wood (e.g. abraded areas) just dab on slightly.

When repairing filled spots (e.g. with König fillers) apply a barrier coat with Special Repair Lacquer PLUS to the ground underneath. To obtain a final sealing, spray again with Special Repair Lacquer PLUS.

From time to time clean the brush tip with a cloth to avoid contamination.

Prevent the brush tip coming into contact with lacquers, e.g. when retouching-up lacquers that have not completely dried. The tip might become sticky or resinous.

Close pen carefully after use – danger of drying up!
